Due to the number of stolen bicycle reports the Phoenix Police Department receives, it is necessary that:

- I immediately notify the Phoenix P.D. if I become aware of the location of the stolen bicycle. _____ (INITIAL)

- I agree to assist in the prosecution of the theft of my bicycle. _____ (INITIAL)

- I agree to notify the Phoenix P.D. and/or create a bill of sale when selling/trading my bicycle. _____ (INITIAL)

- I acknowledge my bicycle will be impounded if the person riding the bicycle is not the registered participant of this program or they do not know the name of the registered participant of this program. _____ (INITIAL)

Under ARS 13-2907.01, it is unlawful for a person to knowingly make to a law enforcement agency of either this state or a political subdivision of this state a false, fraudulent or unfounded report or statement or to knowingly misrepresent a fact for the purpose of interfering with the orderly operation of a law enforcement agency or misleading a peace officer. False Reporting to a law enforcement agency is a class 1 misdemeanor punishable up to six months in jail, \$2,500 fine and three years probation.

When selling/trading a bicycle that is registered in the program, it is important to notify the Phoenix Police Department the bicycle no longer belongs to the registered person and have both parties sign a bill of sale. This can help prevent any civil issues in relation to ownership of the bicycle. If ownership of the bicycle can not be established, then the bicycle will be impounded until the issue can be resolved.
